In order to maintain a safe laboratory environment, the following procedures must be followed before key or card access will be granted to any CBEE Laboratory:

- All labs: EH&S Lab Safety Training on Bridge (6 modules in total) must be completed, certificate produced to PI and CBEE Director of Operations.
